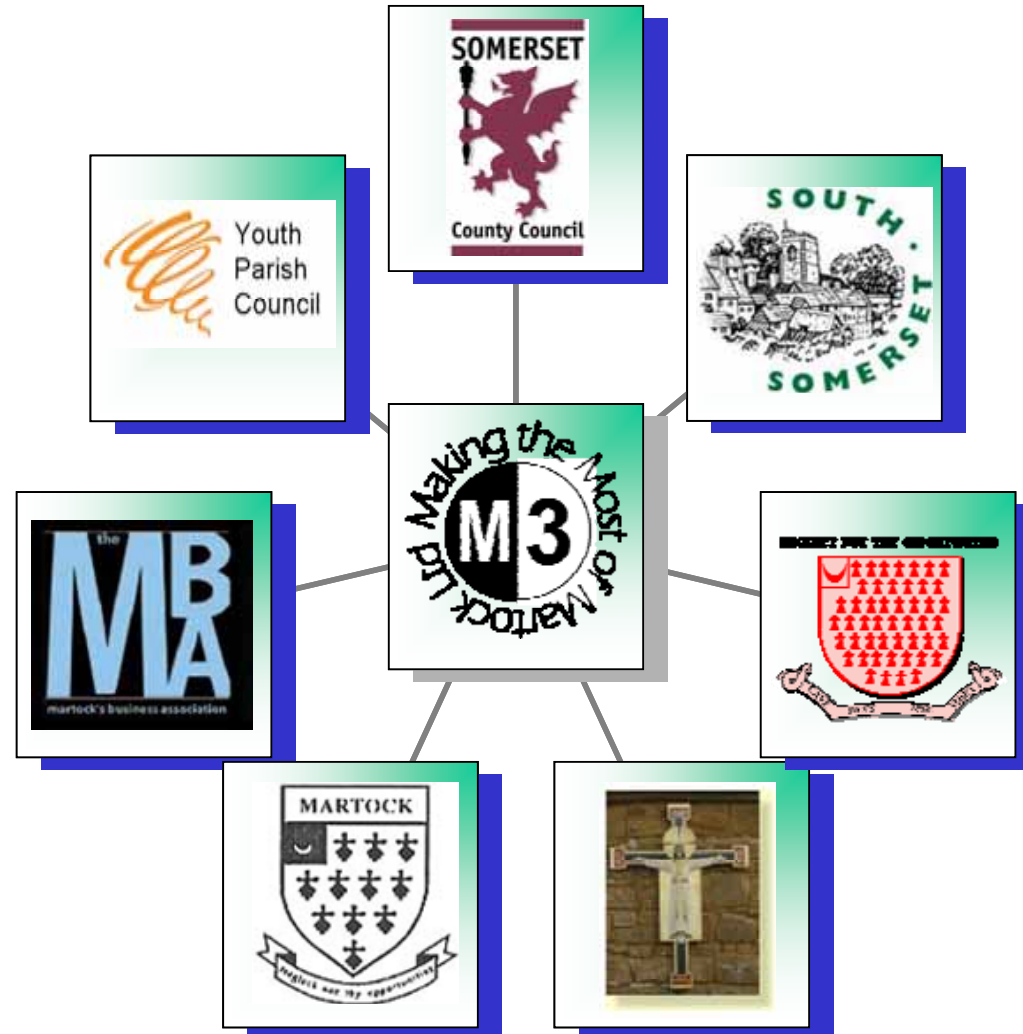

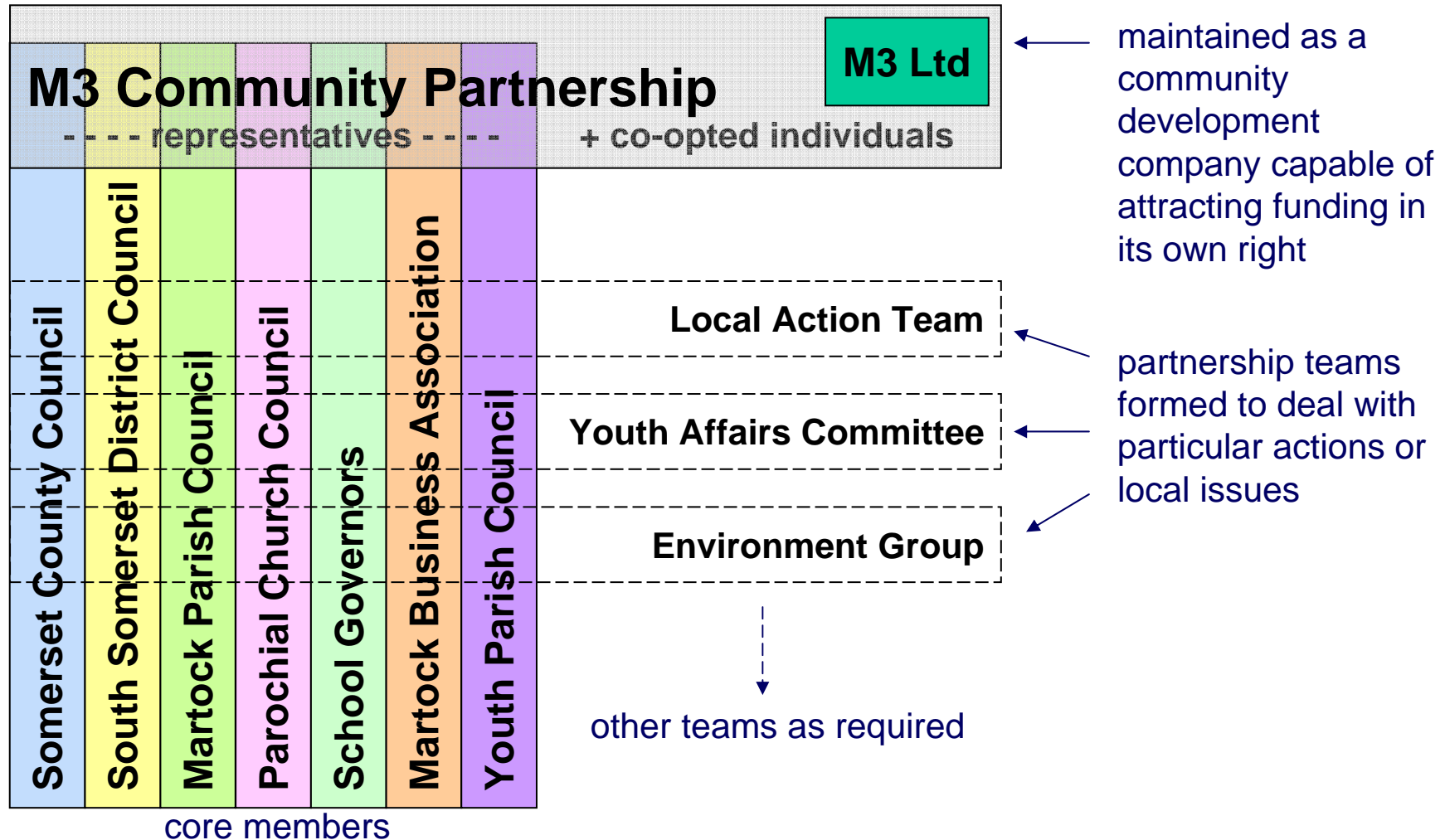
## **Resource**
